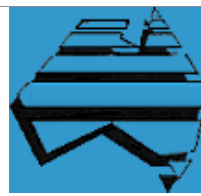

- Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> Jan:** The NAAE BGM, some more elective workshops, and (subject to numbers) an optional tour of the University of Adelaide Roseworthy Campus
